

Exam1, Summer 2017

You will answer 2 of the 3 short answer questions provided, whichever 2 you feel most confident about. Short answer questions will come from the following topic areas:

Molecular inputs and outputs of photosynthesis versus cellular respiration.

The role of phosphorylation in cellular metabolism.

Form and function of the endomembrane system.

The ways in which molecules move across cellular membranes.
